

E91101 - IIS Server Agent PowerShell Remoting

As part of the continued improvement of [XIA Configuration Server](#) the IIS Server agent has been updated.

The agent no longer uses WMI connections and instead uses a single PowerShell remoting connection to scan all information.

The IIS Server agent now supports the following target operating systems:

- Windows Server 2022
- Windows Server 2019
- Windows Server 2016
- Windows Server 2012 R2
- Windows Server 2012
- Windows 11
- Windows 10

T01122 - IIS Servers Client Data Model

The data model for the IIS server agent settings has been updated.

This includes many new optional components and PowerShell remoting settings.

Customers are advised to review the new format of the settings and ensure that the configuration meets their requirements.
